- Facilitate quarterly working groups meetings to support the delivery of the project
- Develop promotional and publicity information across all CCF funded project elements to demonstrate the impact of the project in reducing the carbon footprint of the Broomhill community
- Keep accurate records of all sessions, undertaking simple analysis to assess progress towards agreed goals or outcomes.

- Promote wider sustainable action opportunities across the Broomhill community
